1. 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. Jaduguda is located 25 KM (approx.) from Tatanagar Railway station. 8) **Pro-Rata Deduction on the cost of material for NaOH Content:**

Analysis report of UCIL lab will be final and binding. Pro rata deduction will be made for material belo w the specified grade as under;

- a) 99.5% to 97%: no deduction shall be applicable.
- b) Below 97% up to 96%: single pro-rata deduction on the cost of material.
- c) Below 96%: Rejection of material.

d) In Case of stock out situation, material below 96% will be accepted by UCIL withdouble pro rata de duction on landed cost of material received. However below 95% material will berejected.

e) However below 95% material will be rejected.

Note: In case of a, b & d, material shall not be allowed to take back.

9) Sampling collection and analysis.

- a) Unloading of Caustic soda flakes bags will be done by the supplier at Jaduguda stores or Jaduguda mill as instructed by Section In-charge (Mill).
 - b) Sampling shall be done in the presence of mill representative & CRD representative
 - c) Party may allocate their representative at the time of unloading and sampling, failing which the vehicle driver shall be treated as the party representative.
 - d) During unloading one in every twenty bags must be segregated randomly forcollection. The sa mple will be collected by using hand showel/scoop from the segregated sample bags. The total q uantity of sample collected shall be approx 2 kg in the double layer polythene bags.
 - e) After sample collection in the polythene bag is properly tied at the neck to prevent its ontact with moisture. The tagged sample shall be provided with the party name, Invoic e no, truck no and the sample send to laboratory for analysis.
 - f) Re-sampling of material will not be allowed in any case.
 - g) Analysis report of UCIL shall be treated as final & binding for the sample collected 0.5 & above% of NaOH will be rounded off to next integer & same will be applicable below 0.5% NaOH for round ing off to nearest integer.

For Example:- If analysis value comes to 94.49%, it will be rounded of to 94% & if it c omes 94.50% than it will be rounded of 95%.

- h) Since NaOH hygroscopic material, re-analysis of material will not be allowable.
- 10) **Deviation of Order Quantity:**Up to 10% variations in the execution of purchase order of the total order quantity for sanctioned order value is allowed without issue of amendment / revision in the pur chase order.
- 11) **Related Party Clause:** Subsequent to bid opening, if it is found that bids submitted by related parties i n which there seems to be collusion are liable to be rejected. Parties are considered to be related if o ne party has ability to control the other party or exercise significant influence over the other party in making financial and / or operating decision.

Any disputes or differences relating to int erpretation and application of the provisions of commercial contract(s) between Central Public Se ctor Enterprises (CPSEs) / Port Trusts, inter-se and also between CPSE(s) and Government Depart ment(s) / Organization(s) shall be taken by either party for its resolution through AMRCD.

- d) **ARBITRATION**: Any disputes pr differences where clause no. (c) is not applicable, the parties m ay go for arbitration as per the provisions of Arbitration & conciliation Act, 1996 provided the disp utes is restricted to less than Rs. 10 cr. (Ten Crores). This amount is with reference to the value o f the dispute and not the value of the contract which may be much higher. In all other cases, arbitration shall not be a method of dispute resolution arising out of this contract.
- e) **JURISDICTION**: If the matter is not resolved through above means, the dispute shall be resolve d in civil court of law at Jharkhand only.
