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1. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. 2. 3. OEM Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the OEM of the offered product during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. 4. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. 5. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 30% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of

cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

**1. Generic**

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be  $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$ , subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

**2. Scope of Supply**

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Only supply of Goods

**3. Certificates**

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the

Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

#### 4. **Generic**

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

#### 5. **Generic**

Buyer Organization specific Integrity Pact shall have to be complied by all bidders. Bidders shall have to upload scanned copy of signed integrity pact as per Buyer organizations policy along with bid. [Click here to view the file](#)

#### 6. **Generic**

1. The Seller shall not assign the Contract in whole or part without obtaining the prior written consent of buyer.
2. The Seller shall not sub-contract the Contract in whole or part to any entity without obtaining the prior written consent of buyer.
3. The Seller shall, notwithstanding the consent and assignment/sub-contract, remain jointly and severally liable and responsible to buyer together with the assignee/ sub-contractor, for and in respect of the due performance of the Contract and the Sellers obligations there under.

#### 7. **Generic**

Without prejudice to Buyer's right to price adjustment by way of discount or any other right or remedy available to Buyer, Buyer may terminate the Contract or any part thereof by a written notice to the Seller, if:

- i) The Seller fails to comply with any material term of the Contract.
- ii) The Seller informs Buyer of its inability to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period or such inability otherwise becomes apparent.
- iii) The Seller fails to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period and/or to replace/rectify any rejected or defective Material(s) promptly.
- iv) The Seller becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.
- v) The Seller makes a general assignment for the benefit of creditors.
- vi) A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the Seller.
- vii) The Seller has misrepresented to Buyer, acting on which misrepresentation Buyer has placed the Purchase Order on the Seller.

#### 8. **Inspection**

**Nominated Inspection Agency:** On behalf of the Buyer organization, any one of the following Inspection Agency would be conducting inspection of stores before acceptance:  
Pre-dispatch Inspection at Seller Premises (applicable only if pre-dispatch inspection clause has been selected in ATC):

#### 9. **Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC**

#### 1) **Dispute resolution Mechanism and Jurisdiction:**

- a. **Conciliation:** Notwithstanding anything contained in this contract, any disputes or differences whatsoever, which are to be settled amicably between the parties with their authorized representative,

shall be resolved through conciliation.

- b. **Mediation:** Any disputes or differences, which are not settled amicably through conciliation, then either of the parties, may approach for mediation to settle under mediation Act, 2023. The procedure is to be followed as prescribed in the Mediation Act, 2023 amended from time to time.
- c. **AMRCD:** Any disputes or differences between the parties are not settled amicably with conciliation and/or Mediation, then such disputes or differences shall be resolved through Administrative Mechanism for Resolution of CPSEs Disputes (AMRCD). Any disputes or differences relating to interpretation and application of the provisions of commercial contract(s) between Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) / Port Trusts, inter-se and also between CPSE(s) and Government Department(s) / Organization(s) shall be taken by either party for its resolution through AMRCD.
- d. **ARBITRATION:** Any disputes or differences where clause no. (c) is not applicable, the parties may go for arbitration as per the provisions of Arbitration & conciliation Act, 1996 provided the disputes is restricted to less than Rs. 10 cr. (Ten Crores). This amount is with reference to the value of the dispute and not the value of the contract which may be much higher. In all other cases, arbitration shall not be a method of dispute resolution arising out of this contract.
- e. **Jurisdiction:** If the matter is not resolved through above means, the dispute shall be resolved in civil court of law at Jharkhand only.

- 2) Similar category : Similar Category means Earthmoving heavy equipment or machine or heavy Engine for HMV.
- 3) Guarantee/warranty: Material should be Guaranteed/Warranted for the period of 12 Months from the date of receipt and acceptance of material at our store or 600 Operational running hours from the date of installation within 2 months from the date of receipt and acceptance whichever is earlier.
- 4) Related party clause: Subsequent to bid opening, if it is found that bids submitted by related parties in which there seems to be collusion are liable to be rejected. Parties are considered to be related if one party has ability to control the other party or exercise significant influence over the other party in making financial and / or operating decision.

## Disclaimer/अस्वीकरण

Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
