Bidder has to upload scanned copy / proof of the BC along with bid and has to ensure delivery of hardcopy to the Buyer within 5 days of Bid End date / Bid Opening date.

9. **Generic**

1. The Seller shall not assign the Contract in whole or part without obtaining the prior written consent of buyer.
2. The Seller shall not sub-contract the Contract in whole or part to any entity without obtaining the prior written consent of buyer.
3. The Seller shall, notwithstanding the consent and assignment/sub-contract, remain jointly and severally liable and responsible to buyer together with the assignee/ sub-contractor, for and in respect of the due performance of the Contract and the Sellers obligations there under.

10. **Generic**

Without prejudice to Buyer's right to price adjustment by way of discount or any other right or remedy available to Buyer, Buyer may terminate the Contract or any part thereof by a written notice to the Seller, if:

- i) The Seller fails to comply with any material term of the Contract.
- ii) The Seller informs Buyer of its inability to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period or such inability otherwise becomes apparent.
- iii) The Seller fails to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period and/or to replace/rectify any rejected or defective Material(s) promptly.
- iv) The Seller becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.
- v) The Seller makes a general assignment for the benefit of creditors.
- vi) A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the Seller.
- vii) The Seller has misrepresented to Buyer, acting on which misrepresentation Buyer has placed the Purchase Order on the Seller.

11. **Inspection**

12. **Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC**

9. Mode of supply and place of delivery: The material shall be delivered at UCIL Explosive Magazine located at Jharia and Banduhurang Mine in the East Singhbhum, Jharkhand State which is about 26KM and 10KM from Tatanagar Railway station respectively via road by Explosive Van having Valid license.
10. Delivery Schedule as and when required basis within the period of 365 days.
11. Delivery of material shall start within 30 days from the date of issue of RE-11 and written instruction from Asst. Manager, Banduhurang Mines/In charge Explosive, Jaduguda. Material to be delivered in compliance within Explosive Act-1984 and amended by the Explosive rule, 2008.
12. Splitting of tender quantity: To ensure smooth supply, effort will be made to split the quantity of on L1 (lowest) and L2 (2nd lowest) bidders in the ratio of 60% and 40 % respectively, subject to matching L1 bidders rate by L2 bidder. 18. **Dispute resolution Mechanism and Jurisdiction:**
- Conciliation:** Notwithstanding anything contained in this contract, any disputes or differences whatsoever, which are to be settled amicably between the parties with their authorized representative, shall be resolved through conciliation.
 - Mediation:** Any disputes or differences, which are not settled amicably through conciliation, then either of the parties, may approach for mediation to settle under mediation Act, 2023. The procedure is to be followed as prescribed in the Mediation Act, 2023 amended from time to time.
 - AMRCD:** Any disputes or differences between the parties are not settled amicably with conciliation and/or Mediation, then such disputes or differences shall be resolved through Administrative Mechanism for Resolution of CPSEs Disputes (AMRCD). Any disputes or differences relating to interpretation and application of the provisions of commercial contract(s) between Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) / Port Trusts, inter-se and also between CPSE(s) and Government Department(s) / Organization(s) shall be taken by either party for its resolution through AMRCD.
 - ARBITRATION:** Any disputes or differences where clause no. (c) is not applicable, then the parties may go for arbitration as per the provisions of Arbitration & conciliation Act, 1996 provided the disputes is restricted to less than Rs. 10 cr. (Ten Crores).
